
Now, on this day, comes Collector Rachel Boyce and Assessor Rita Lemmon and makes proper showing to the Court, under oath, that the assessment address on the following described property Parcel #89-08-3.2-05-000-000-008.001, Halfway, Mo was not corrected in the Assessor's system for two years and therefore taxpayer never received the statement and assumed this parcel was included in another tax statement for the years 2022 and 2023.

The Court, after hearing the evidence, finds that said address on this parcel was incorrect in the Assessor's system due to an oversight error in the Assessor's office, but said address has now been corrected.

It is, therefore, Ordered and Adjudged that said late fees and interest be refunded in the amount of \$78.18 and be given to Cletus Ingram. 
