Dadeville R-II School District Proposition Dadeville Bearcats 1

Shall the Board of Education of the Dadeville R-II School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of One Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000) for the purpose of providing funds to demolish an existing building; to complete the site development, construction, equipping, and furnishing of a new building with additional classrooms; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.9900 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
