1. That Nathan Hubbard, as owner of said property, (hereinafter the "Petitioners") filed on or about the 5th of January 2026, a Petition (hereinafter the "Petition") with the Commission to vacate a street pursuant to RSMo. §71.270.
2. No vacation shall be ordered until proof shall be made to the commission of the publication in a newspaper published in the county or of written or printed notices posted in five public places in the county, at least fifteen days prior to the term of the commission at which such petition shall be presented, that application would be made at that term of the commission for the vacation of the street, avenue, road, alley, public easement, public square or common, or part thereof, as described in the petition.
